WELCOME

The Hungarian National Skating Federation and the Organizing Committee are glad to invite you and your club to participate in the "JÉGVIRÁG" CUP 2022.

The Organizers reserve the right to change the date, location, and program of the competition. When submitting an entry all competitors acknowledge that due to the COVID-19 pandemic situation and public health issues the Organizers can only host the competition in accordance with the effective medical and government regulations and has the solemn right to cancel the competition at any time or to host it between closed doors with a limited number of competitors and no spectators. The competitors also acknowledge that in case laws forbid it the Organizers are unable to hold the competition. Furthermore, in case the competition cannot take place due to legal restrictions or public health issues the Organizers bear no responsibility for any damage resulting from the cancellation and thus no claims can be made towards the Organizers. The Organizers are not obliged to assign a new date for the competition if it is cancelled because of the above-mentioned reasons. The competitors acknowledge that upon cancellation of the competition they do not have the right to claim back the already paid entry fee as the Organizers had various costs concerning the competition.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

The "JÉGVIRÁG" CUP 2022 Interclub Competition in Figure Skating and Ice Dance will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2021, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2021, and the relevant ISU Communications.

All Members of the ISU and Clubs being members of National Skating Federations associated with the ISU, are invited to take part in the competition.

Participation in the "JÉGVIRÁG" CUP is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 in accordance with the ISU General Regulations 2021 or any update of this and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. **Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented for verification at the accreditation of the event.**

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE GIRLS and BOYS

according to ISU Communication No.2396 and subsequent updates.

Free Skating Duration: 3 min +/- 10 sec.

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE ICE DANCE

according to ISU Communications No.2374, 2393 and subsequent updates.

Pattern Dances

One of the two groups announced for the season shall be drawn before the first practice of the competition. Each group contains two (2) Pattern Dances.

The following pattern dances to be skated:

Group 3: Foxtrot and European Waltz Group 4: Kilian and Starlight Waltz

Couples shall provide their own music for all Pattern Dances.

<u>Free Dance</u> Duration: 2:30 min. +/- 10 sec.

BASIC NOVICE GIRLS and BOYS

according to ISU Communication No.2396 and subsequent updates.

<u>Free Skating</u> Duration: 2'30 min +/- 10 sec.

BASIC NOVICE ICE DANCE

according to ISU Communications No.2374, 2393 and subsequent updates.

Pattern Dances

Two of the three Pattern Dances announced for the season shall be published the latest at the draw of the competition.

From three (3) Pattern Dances, two (2) Pattern Dances are to be skated from the following:

- Foxtrot, Dutch Waltz and Rhythm Blues

Couples shall provide their own music for all Pattern Dances.

Free Dance Duration: 2:00 min. +/. 10 sec.

YOUNGER CATEGORIES

CUBS GIRLS and BOYS - Born after 1st of July 2011 – Before 30th of June 2012 **MINI CUBS GIRLS and BOYS** - Born after 1st of July 2012 - Before 30th of June 2013

Free Skating Duration: 2'30 min. +/- 10 sec.

a) Maximum of 5 jump elements for Girls and Boys, and one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. A jump sequence consists of 2 (two) jumps of any number of revolutions, beginning with any jump, immediately followed by an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump to the take-off curve of the Axel jump.

Jump combination can contain only two jumps. Only two jumps with 1, 1 ¹/₂, 2 or 2 ¹/₂. revolutions can be repeated once. Triple jumps are not permitted.

b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no changeof position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed in both spins.

d) In case of fall the deduction will be -0,5 by the Technical Panel

The Program Components are only judged in

- Skating Skills
- Performance/Execution

The factors of the Program Components are

Boys 2.5 Girls 2.5

Levels explanations

For Cubs and Mini Cubs Singles, in all elements, which are subject to Levels, only features up to **Level 2** will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

CHICKS GIRLS and BOYS - Born after 1st of July 2013 - Before 30th of June 2014 **MINI CHICKS GIRLS and BOYS** - Born after 1st of July 2014

Free Skating

Duration: 2'00 min. +/- 10 sec.

GIRLS and BOYS

- a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, and one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. A jump sequence consists of 2 (two) jumps of any number of revolutions, beginning with any jump, immediately followed by an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump to the take-off curve of the Axel jump. A jump combination can contain only two jumps. Only two jumps with 1, 1 ½, 2 or 2 ½ revolutions can be repeated once. Triple jumps are not permitted.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no changeof position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed in both spins.
- c) There must be a maximum:

One (1) choreo sequence with one spiral position with 3 sec. and one step sequence $\frac{1}{2}$ utilizing the ice surface. The choreo sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

d) In case of fall the deduction will be -0,5 by the Technical Panel

The Program Components are only judged in

- Skating Skills
- Performance

The factors of the Program Components are

Boys	2.5
Girls	2.5

Levels explanations

For Chicks ISU 7 and younger Singles, in all elements, which are subject to Levels, only features up to **Level 2** will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.



<u>ENTRIES</u>

ENTRIES BY NAME

All Members / Clubs, which are members of National Figure Skating Federations associated with the ISU, may enter competitors in each category. The OC reserves the right to limit the number of participants to one (1) Entry in each category in case of overcrowding. With the Entry forms, the "Program Content Sheet" must also be returned to the Organizing Committee in due time (**by January 14**th **at the latest**). It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet mustbe filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. It is not permitted to hand over the Program Content Sheets directly to the acting Officials.

ENTRIES OF JUDGES

Each participating ISU Member may nominate Judges for the event. Only at least International Judges will be accepted. The OC reserves the right to limit the number of judges in accordance with the number of the Skaters' Entries. The Organizing Committee will only cover the board and lodging **for judges accepted in the panel only** for the period: from the dinner before the day of their activity until the end of their activity. Please, be aware that judges not involved in the panel have to cover their own expenses (board and lodging).

The confirmation of the list of judges will be announced until 18th January 2022.

DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES

The names of all team members must be submitted on the official forms and must reach the Organizing Committee not later than:

11th January 2022 at the latest

If you fail to make payment until deadline the following entry fees will apply 100 EURO or 36.000 HUF/person, 150 EURO or 54.000 HUF/couple

PAYMENTS

Entry Fees are requested to be paid **only** by **bank transfer until 31**st **January 2022 at the latest. Please note that all banking charges have to be borne by the sender.** In order to reduce the occurring banking charges, the Organizing Committee welcomes combined payment, as it is allowed to pay the entry fees for more or all skaters per club or Member Federation via one transfer. When making the payment, please use the comment field for: 'FS'+ 3-digit country code + family name of skaters (e.g. FS HUN Kovacs)

Entry fees concerning cancellations arriving after 24:00 o'clock Friday, 2nd February 2022 at local time and in case of no-show at the competition will not be paid back.

<u>EXPENSES</u>

The Organizer covers the expenses of competition, organization, awards and board & lodging only for judges on duty (announced until 28th January 2022). Travel expenses to and from Miskolc, transfer costs to and from the Official Hotel and Airport **will be covered** by the organizer.

The expenses for rooms and meals, travel and transfer of the Team Leaders, Competitors and other Team officials **will not be covered** by the organizer and are on the account of the Teams.

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the "Jégvirág" Cup 2022, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue who shall pay the premium for such insurance.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.



<u>DRAW</u>

Draws for the categories CHICKS, MINI CHICKS, CUBS, MINI CUBS, BASIC NOVICE and INTERMEDIATE NOVICE will be done by electronic random draw, on the day preceding the event and will be published on the same day. Starting order for the free dance will be reverse order after the pattern dances.

Please be informed that only those competitors whose entry fee will have arrived until the time of the draw of the given category, will be drawn for the competition.

<u> PROGRAM SCHEDULE – STARTING TIMES</u>

Please, be informed that only the category starting times are fixed and that all changes in entries and Preliminary Program might be followed at <u>www.jegviragcup.com</u> and on the information board in the ice rink.

<u>MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT</u>

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

- the ISU Member is responsible for submitting their Competitor's music as direct attachment to an email to the Organizing Committee (scc@hunskate.hu) until 2nd February 2022. Please note: some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an email-based transfer service which allows to send large files could be used to send the file to the OC.

- each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s):

GBR_IN_FD_EXAMPLE-John

- the music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable. Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.
- Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.
- The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at the time of registration.
- Please note: CDs will not be accepted by the Organizing Committee

Program Component sheets have to be sent to the Organizing Committee latest by 2nd February 2022.

PRESENTATION OF MEDALS

The three best placed Skaters/Couples in each event will be announced and honored. Gold, silver and bronze medals and cups will be presented to the medalists. All participants will receive a diploma with their placement. The exact time of the Awarding Ceremonies will be announced in the detailed schedule in due time. Please make sure that all skaters are represented at the Ceremony.
